To ensure that your new multi-point door lock functions correctly please follow the operating instructions below.


Lever/Lever Operation

To lock (from inside or outside)

- Close the door firmly to engage the latch (do not depress handle).
- Lift the lever up to throw the hooks to locked position
- 3. Turn the key to deadlock

To unlock (from inside or outside)

- 1. Turn the key to unlock the deadbolt
- Push lever down to disengage the hooks and latch
- 3. Open the door



Lever/Lever Night Latch Operation

To lock (from inside or outside)

- 1. Close the door firmly to engage the latch (do not depress handle).
- Lift the lever/pad up to throw the hooks to locked position
- 3. Turn the key to deadlock

To unlock (from outside)

- Turn the key to withdraw deadlock "unlock" (let go of key)
- Push lever down to disengage the hooks only (let go of lever)
- Turn key again in same direction to disengage the latch


To unlock (from inside)

Follow lever/lever instructions above.

Latch retainment

If your handle is fitted with the optional latch retainer button –

To hold the latch: withdraw latch and hold, slide snib on faceplate upwards. Latch is held. **To release:** Slide snib downwards.
