Yale 8V001 Fitting Instructions

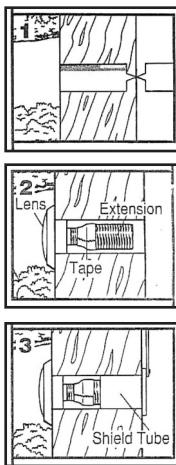
Prior to fitting familiarise yourself with its simple operation

Mark position of viewer on outside of door. Carefully drill a 13mm dia. hole through the door until drill breaks through on the inner face. Working from inside complete drilling. **Ensure drill is level and straight. (fig1)**

Unscrew door viewer into its three parts, lens, central extension and shield tube. Measure door thickness then adjust length of viewer to suit ensuring equal lengths of engagement each end. Place a small piece of tape around lens and extension tube (this prevents disengagement when screwing shield tube into place).(fig2)

Place lens through door from outside then from inside fit shield tube which can be screwed in with a large bladed screwdriver or coin. **Do not overtighten (fig3)**

When cleaning do not use abrasive cleaners, solvents or polish. Only use moist soft cloth.
