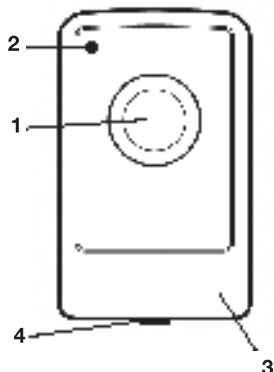


## Panic Button (EF-PB)



### Description

1. Activation/Learn Button (Red): Use for activating the alarm and for learning-in.
2. LED Indicator for activation and low battery.
3. Knockouts for wall mounting (under backplate)
4. Cover securing screw

### Inside the Box

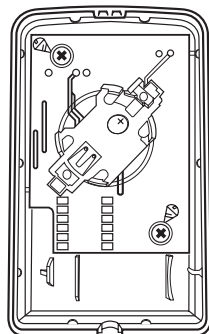
- 1 x Panic Button
- 2 x wall plugs/cross head fixing screws.
- 1 x CR2032 coin cell battery

Program your Panic Button before installation and test afterwards. Please see your current Alarm user manual.

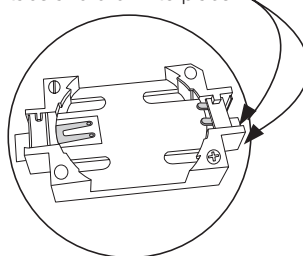


#### Installation:

Undo the cover screw and insert the battery with the side uppermost.

Press battery into holder fly with finger and thumb until a click is heard (see picture below)

Insert the battery under the two tabs and click into place.

**Location:**

The Panic Button provides extra protection for you and your family. When help is needed the Panic Button can activate your alarm immediately - even when the system is disarmed.

- Mount at chest height for ease of use
- Mount on flat wall surface
- Designed for indoor use only
- Out of reach of children
- Hidden from view while easily accessible
- Not clearly visible to an intruder
- Easily accessible
- Indoor use only

**Mounting:**

The Panic Button can be used free standing or wall mounted. For wall mounting:

- Break through the 2 knockouts in the backplate of the Panic Button
- Drill holes on the wall surface using the holes as template. Insert wall plugs and screw the backplate to the wall.
- Fix the Panic Button in place on the backplate and tighten case screw.

## Operation

**Activation:**

Press and hold the red button for at least 3 seconds. LED will light momentarily and the alarm will be activated.

**Silence an Alarm:**

Press and hold the red button for at least 10 seconds. LED will light momentarily and the alarm will be silenced.

**NOTE:** Silencing the alarm with the Panic Button does not reset the system. If the alarm is armed prior to activation, the system will re-arm after being silenced with the Panic Button.
